COVID-19 UPDATE

On March 17, 2020, we received a formal communication from the Aquatics/Gymnastics Unit Manager from Cobb County Parks stating that all recreation centers, aquatic centers, gymnastics centers, art centers, and all other parks will be closed until further notice. The Cobb County Parks Department will continue to monitor the current conditions concerning the COVID-19 virus and will work with the organizations that use the facilities to determine when the best time will be to resume practice and facility usage.

The Board of Directors has made the difficult decision to temporarily suspend the Cobb Challengers Program until the gymnastics facility will reopen for training. A temporary suspension will allow our program to 'weather the storm' during the next few months as the Coronavirus pandemic impacts our community. While the fundraising dollars we raised were slated for other purposes, in light of this pandemic, we have decided to repurpose the dollars to financially support our coaches during this time while maintaining a financial balance to allow us the opportunity to reopen our doors in the future.

What does this mean for our gymnast's families and coaches?

Gymnast's Families - We have decided to suspend all tuition payments until we are able to reinstate the tuition payment process. This means that all auto-payments will be suspended. The Program Director, Christophe Voisin, is currently processing the meet cancellation fees and your account will be credited by the end of this week.

Coaches - We have decided to pay our coaches for the next pay cycle, ending March 31. After this time, all of our coaches will be placed on 'unpaid leave'.

We are happy to report that the gymnast exhibiting possible symptoms of COVID-19 is improving. While the gymnast was never tested for the virus, she is getting better each day.

Please check your email frequently as new/changing information will be shared as soon as we receive it.
