Parent Volunteer Requirements



As we discussed during our October Parent Meeting, **all** parents of competitive and non-competitive gymnasts are required to work a home meet.

- **Competitive Team Parents must work two (2) Home Meets per season** - Gymstars; Xcel Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum; USA Levels 3-5; Optionals Levels 6-10
- **Non-competitive must work one (1) Home Meet per season** - Training Team and Developmental Team

If you have not met this requirement, you will need to sign up on the Sign-Up Genius email.

**Please Note: Failure to work the required number of meets will result in a \$100.00 charge to your account.*

***Failure to SHOW UP for a confirmed work session for a meet will result in a \$150.00 charge to your account.*

Set-Up and/or Tear Down Committee

The Program Director will lead a team on Saturday and Sunday for the set-up and tear-down of the equipment needed for the meet.

On Saturday, March 7, 2020, from 2:00 - 4:00 pm, the Set-Up Committee (8 volunteers needed) will do the following -

- Move unused mats from the competition floor
- Clean mats that will be utilized for the competition
- Move the Boys' bar equipment
- Move the Competition Beam to the desired location
- Assemble and the pipe and draping to conceal unused areas

****Please Note - This volunteer opportunity may require heavy lifting***

On Sunday, March 8, 2020, immediately following the competition ~ 7:15 - 10:15 pm, the Tear-Down Committee (8 volunteers needed) will do the following -

- Reset the training area for Monday's sessions

****Parents who are able to sign up for both the Set-Up and Tear-Down opportunities (total of 5 hours) will receive receive their participation requirement plus \$100.00 off of your gymnast's monthly tuition.**

- **Admissions***
 - Accept admissions - Cash and Credit Cards accepted
 - \$8.00 Adult; \$5.00 Military/Seniors/Children
 - 'Wish-a-Grams' and Rotation Sheet Sales
- **Concessions***
 - Food Sales and Restocking
 - Minimal Food Preparation
 - Leotard Consignment Sales
- **Timers/Awards***
 - Time Equipment use during warm-up and meet for bars, beam, or floor
 - Make sure medals, plaques, team signs are organized and in place for meet distribution
 - Help organize teams with signs and March In
 - Distribute Awards after competition

 - Organize teams with signs
 - Direct March In
 - Fill-In for No-Shows
- **Hospitality***
 - Help with distribution of food to dining areas (judges and coaches)
